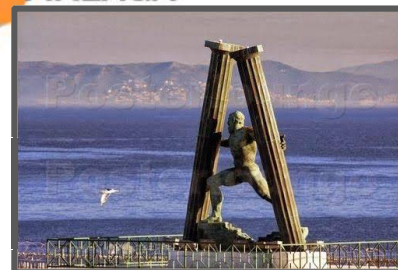

Galician language is spoken in Galicia.



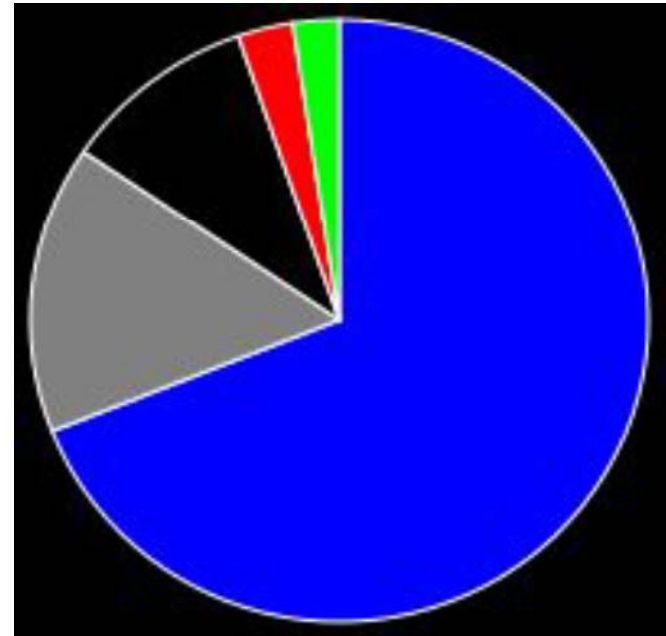
Among the religions in Spain, Christianity is the most practised Catholicism 69%

- Non declared 2,4%

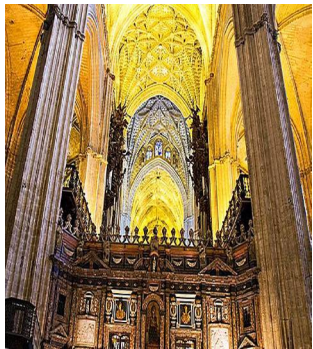
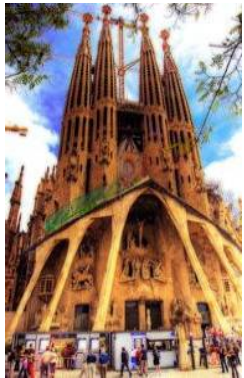

Finca Güell

This estate was Gaudí's first work for the man who became his patron and his friend, and it marked the beginning of an intense and productive professional relationship.

Güell owned several estates in Barcelona, in the district known today as Zona Universitaria, and he commissioned Gaudí to design the boundary wall and the gates giving access to this property. He also subsequently asked the architect to build the stables and various other small buildings. In these, Gaudí used, for the first time, cut pieces of tiles in the form of a mosaic, in a style which has become universally known as trencadís, from the Catalan word trencar, meaning "to break" in English.



Corrida

Fighting bulls is a real ritual in Spain, in which the most important is the way man and bull "come together". This is seen as art, not as cruelty.

La Tomatina

However, the most famous Tomato Day - La Tomatina, is celebrated in the Spanish town of Bunol near Valencia.

Dead

As for All Saints, in Spain there has been a custom of cremating corpses for many years, and cemeteries resemble parks with stone multi-story tombs, in which urns with ashes are stored.

Castells, or towers of people

Spanish cuisines can be divided by regions of Spain.

Northern Spain:

North Spanish cuisine is dominated by fish and seafood from the Atlantic.

East Spain:

The cuisine of the east coast of Spain was influenced by foreign cultures, especially Roman and Arabic.

Southern Spain:

The region of southern Spain is Andalusian cuisine, which has Arabic traditions.

Central Spain

Venison, pheasants and partridges are served all over central Spain, while frogs and ropes are also eaten in Extremadura.

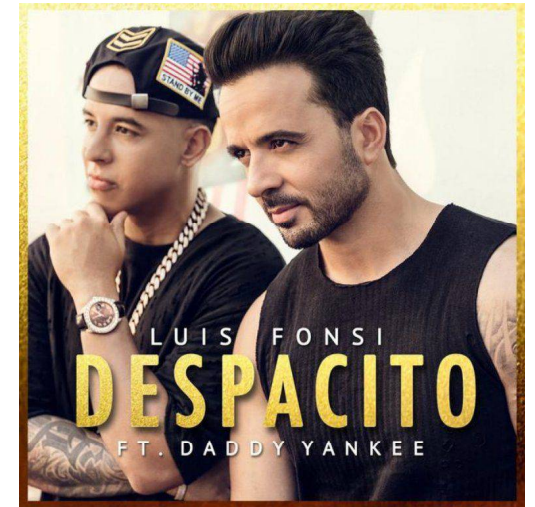


- Paella- traditional spanish dish. In it is rice with carry and sea fruit
